

Multimedia Art Contest.....

Prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in each age group:

Keepsake plaque + gift bag that includes a book by an author of color and goodies. Artwork will be printed in the Northwest Asian Weekly in the March 1 and March 8 issues. Must be present to win gift bag.

Prizes for finalists:

Several finalists will be selected. Each finalist will receive a gift bag that includes a book by an author of color, goodies and certificate of merit. Artwork will be printed in the Northwest Asian Weekly in the March 1 and March 8 issues. Must be present to win the gift bag.

Prizes for all participants:

All participants will receive certificates recognizing their participation.

Art contest guidelines:

1. Use the theme "Happy Pig" in the artwork.
2. To encourage artistic expression, we allow participants to create work in any artistic format. It can be paper-cut art, paper-folding, photographs, computerized art, drawings or wax/clay sculptures. The artwork should not be restricted to the image of a single pig; images and depictions of several pigs (e.g. a pig farm) can be submitted.
3. Art must be no larger than 8 1/2 inches by 11 inches by 8 inches. It can be one-dimensional or three-dimensional.
4. Make full use of color.
5. Artwork will be judged on originality and creativity, entertainment value, best expression of the theme, best use of medium and materials, and craftsmanship.
6. Limit 2 entries per student.

Judging:

A panel of judges will review all artwork and identify the finalists. The winners will be selected from the group of finalists.

Who can participate:

Students ages 6-18 who are residents of Washington state are eligible to enter the contest. The contest will be separated into three categories: ages 6-9, ages 10-14 and ages 15-18.

Deadline:

All entries must be received by the Northwest Asian Weekly by Feb. 20, 2007.
